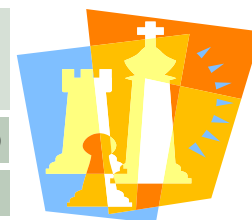

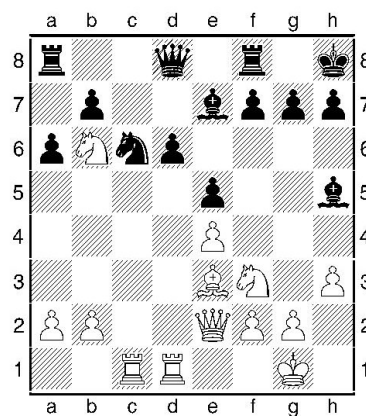

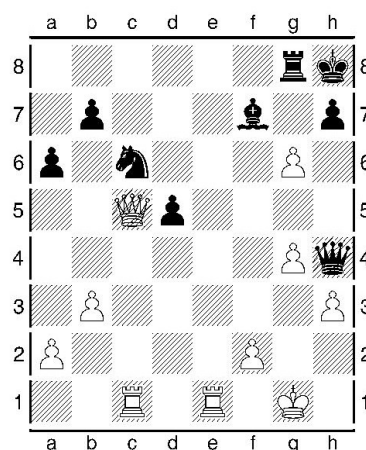

Bill played very well in the opening and convincingly outplayed his opponent. But when it was time to get big advantage Bill blundered. Chess game, like real life, is not always fair. I think this game shows that one can always get lucky as blunders are normal to a chess game. Does not matter how strong a player is, even a world champion might blunder!
