### **2012 Australian Junior Championships**

The 2012 Australian Junior Chess Championships broke all the records, with 276 competitors. Feedback from parents and kids was very positive. The venue, Spensley Street Primary School in Clifton Hill, worked really well. The main hall had plenty of parent viewing areas and adequate space for over 70 games. The U16 and U18 tournaments were held in the library away from all the noise and bustle. The grounds were great for the children to play soccer, cricket, basket ball and down ball - between rounds everywhere I looked there were kids playing. The smaller ones had a great play ground as well. Parents had enough space to sit down and chill out, while a daily barbeque and cafe created a real buzz of excitement. The school was also able to provide some extra rooms at the last minute for state coaching.

I have heard that a lot of parents and grand parents really enjoyed seeing the games up on Tornado when they could not be there themselves. Mostly the kids entered their own games with their opponent (which was really nice to see), but the upper age groups had somebody walking around entering games live as they were being played.

For me the highlight was taking 5 minutes out to soak in the energy of 80 kids working furiously on their problem solving paper. I could really feel the intense concentration as the kids got lost in their solving.

most encouraging for junior chess in Australia to see the biggest area of growth in the competition being the U14s (this division was over 50% bigger than 2011) with a lot of the U12 players from last year now playing in the U14s. This is a strong indication that the new format is working and will start filtering more players up to the higher age groups. Another interesting statistic was that there were 10 Daniels competing, which would have made a nice round robin.

I really appreciated the help from the many volunteers and I would specially like to thank David Corcover, Kylie Soo and Charles Zworestine who put in a huge amount of effort before and during the competition to make it all work
