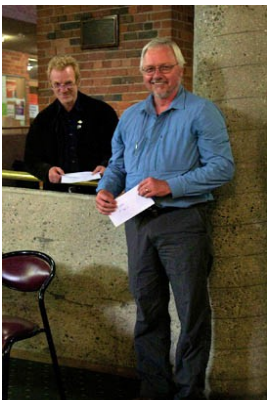

2012 Ballarat Begonia Festival tournament

32 [counting a few borderline cases] of Canterbury Junior and Box Hill members made the annual trip to the Central highlands of Victoria, with some mixed results. Out of the top 18 of the massive field of 131 there were the following:

I have absolutely no information on the individual performances, suffice to say that going into the last round Chris Wallis had a good chance for equal first but lost to the relatively unknown Queenslander Brodie McClymont,

who by winning was elevated to equal first. In the bottom half of the table there were good result for Marko Grabovac on 3.5 and Jody Middleton and Amelia Mendes sticking close on 2.5. So sorry For Alanna Chew Lee who on 2 out of 2 at the end of day one got no further score. I know how it feels, I have been there myself
As usual in Victorian tournaments there is no information on the prizes

March ACF ratings

In the just published March national ratings list we see Canterbury Junior Coach GM Darryl Johansen returning to the top 4 with a rating of 2493 list however still well behind the massive rating of 2575 of GM Zong-Yuan Zhao. Bobby Cheng came in at no17 with a rating of 2362, Chris Wallis at 24 with a rating of 2323, and Eugene Schön snuck into the top 40 at 36 with a rating of 2238.

The rapid ratings are also out but we do not have the luxury of the big improvers or the top players in the presentation. Victorian players are handicapped by the lack of support for the system by many Victorian clubs. In fact only ourselves and Ranges submitted tournaments in this rating period.
