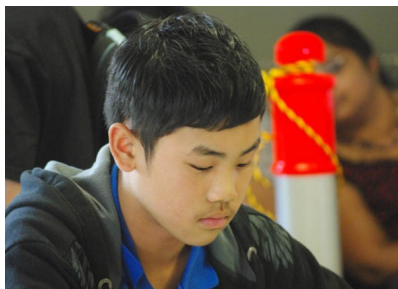

2012 March Rookies Cup a follow up

Following May Yi Foo's meritorious win in the March rookies event the organisers have realised that the rules need some refining as the rookies winner does not necessarily come from rating group one nor does it have to be a boy. So after some tweaking this is what we came up with

- Prizes
- 1 Rookies Cup trophy and prize of \$40, goes to the highest finishing junior player in the whole tournament
 - 2 Queens Cup trophy and prize of \$25 goes to the highest girl who is not the Rookies Cup trophy winner
 - 3 One Rating group trophy go to the highest placed junior in each rating group Ties .
- Ties for trophy places will be resolved on count back systems in the following order 1 Progressive scores. 2 Buchholzs. 3 Number of wins.

Equal placed players losing on count back will share prize money [if any] and be issued with inscribed medallions.

Annual Trophies

The winner of each month's Rookies and Queens Cup trophy will have their names engraved on the annual trophies, with the most frequent winners receiving the trophy at the end of the calendar year, with the proviso that in the case of a girl player winning the Rookies trophy she will also also share a place towards the Queens Cup

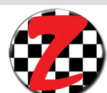
